We are pleased to offer students of The Queen City Academy Charter School access to the school computer network and the Internet. To gain independent access to the Internet and school computer network, all students must obtain parental permission and must sign and return this form to the Technology Teacher.

Internet access and other online services for educational purposes offer students a multitude of resources to explore. Our goal is to provide the opportunity for all students to have access to technology tools, resources, and services when they act in a responsible, efficient, courteous and legal manner.

Students are expected to exercise the same good behaviors on school computer networks as they do in a classroom or a school hallway. This access is a privilege, not a right, and entails responsibility. The following activities are not permitted:

- Sending or displaying offensive messages or pictures, pornography, etc.
- Seeking, sending, or displaying offensive and inappropriate messages
- Harassing, insulting, or attacking others
- Violating copyright laws
- Trespassing in another's folder, work or files
- Sharing password with anyone other than a trusted adult
- Using an account belonging to another person
- Damaging and/or tampering computers, computer systems, or computer networks
- Intentionally disrupting network traffic or crashing the network
- Employing the network for commercial purposes

Violations may result in a loss of access as well as other disciplinary or legal action.

The school supports and respects parents' rights to decide whether or not their children will apply to this resource. In addition, the school requires these students to be trained in order to cover the basic information and rules about using this resource. The form on the reverse of this page **must be signed and returned** to the homeroom teacher or your child will not have access to the Internet.
